

MREA Back 40 Campground

1215 County Road QQ, Custer, WI

Welcome to the Back 40 Campground. Located on 39 acres of wooded property, Midwest Renewable Energy Association's (MREA) rustic campground is only about one mile from The Energy Fair! Park your car for the weekend, while you walk, ride your bike, or take the frequent shuttle to The Energy Fair. A shower trailer and porta-poties are available for your use.



Things to know:

- Limited water is available in the campground. You may want to bring water jugs to carry water.
- Since butane stove use is allowed only on a table, you are encouraged to use the picnic tables to cook in the common picnic area. You may also bring a card table.
- There are no overhead or night lights at the campground. Please bring a flashlight.
- Cty Rd QQ is busy, please watch for traffic. Do not block lanes. Walk or ride on the edge of the road.
- The edge of the campground is marked with fences on all sides, please do not trespass onto our neighbor's private property. Violators will be prosecuted.
- Tents must be smaller than 12 feet.
- Each tent site, excluding walk-in sites accommodate only one car.
- No refunds will be given.

Shuttle Schedule:

- Shuttle bus will run from the Back 40 to The Energy Fair every 15 minutes:
Friday and Saturday 7:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.
Sunday 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Evening Entertainment Special:

- Stay for music on Friday and Saturday. The "night train" will take you back to the Back 40 running from 10:45 p.m. until 11:30 p.m.

In Case of Emergency:

- Dial 911. You are located at 1215 County Road QQ in the Town Stockton, Portage County.
- The Campground Host has a fire extinguisher at the check-in site near the entrance.

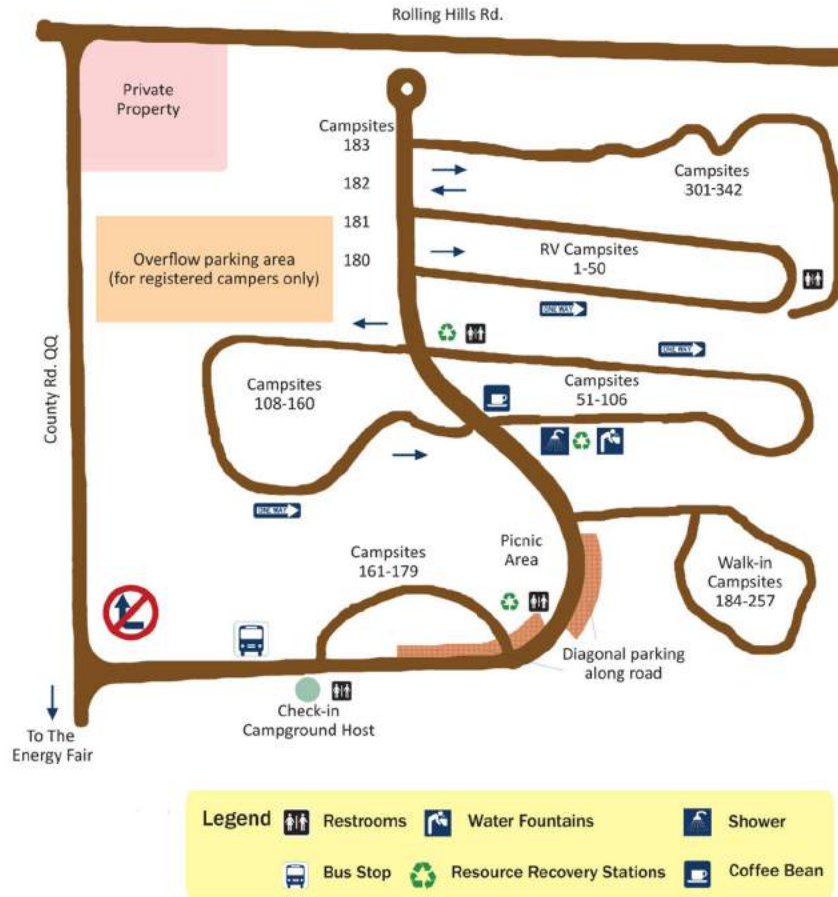

Campground Use

MREA has temporary permission to use this property from the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department and our neighbors. In order to be granted long-term permission we must follow these rules strictly. Thus we ask for your cooperation with the rules outlined below.



Back 40 Campground Rules:

1. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily. Please shut off all generators and music. Keep voices low.
2. No pets allowed.
3. No open fires, grills, or smoking in the campground. Fire danger is extremely high in the woods.
4. Coleman butane stoves and gas lanterns are only allowed if on a table and are not to be left unattended at any time.
5. Do not visit the neighbors! You will be trespassing. Stay on campground roads and trails.
6. No parking (or U-turns) on County Road QQ or Rolling Hills Road.
7. Back 40 Campground is for camper parking only.
8. No site substitutions are allowed.
9. No RV discharge allowed onsite.
10. Keep food, leftovers, and snacks in your closed vehicle when not eating.
11. Place recyclables and trash in appropriate bins immediately after use.
12. Please leave picnic tables in common picnic area. Do not move them to your site.

Violation of any of the above rules will result in immediate expulsion from the campground.
